25-Mar-17 Deputies were dispatched to a cold accident that occurred on March 25, 2017 at approximately 2:00 PM in front of the Akron News Reporter. An elderly resident claimed to have struck a parked vehicle and had moderate damage to her vehicle. Deputies have been unable to locate what was struck.

25-Mar-17 Deputies arrested Mary Partch on a warrant out of Washington County Courts for failure to comply. Mrs. Partch was also actively violating a mandatory protection order. Mrs. Partch was arrested and transported to the Washington County Justice Center. She was later released on a PR Bond.

25-Mar-17 Deputies were dispatched to the area of 7th & Bent on reports of a light blue 4 door sedan shooting an airsoft pistol towards people. Deputies were unable to find the vehicle or any suspects. Case is under investigation.

26-Mar-17 Deputies were dispatched to a dispute between two people on Hwy 34 at approximetaly CO RD W. After completing an investigation, Juan Arteaga was issued a summons for harassment.

27-Mar-17 Deputies took a report of a firearm that was stolen from a residence in Woodrow. The firearm was taken between Jan. 27th, 2017 thru Mar. 1st, 2017 while the residents were out of town. This case is under investigation.

28-Mar-17 Deputies were dispatched to a residence in the Town of Akron for a party with possible mental health issues. The individual was transported to the East Morgan County Hospital. Deputies have been called back to the residence two more times for the same issue.

28-Mar-17 Deputies responded to the Washington County Courts on an alarm. Upon arrival, the presiding judge ordered that Wesley Lefforge serve a sentence in jail for contempt of court in connection with a civil action. Mr. Lefforge was taken into custody and will serve 20 days.

28-Mar-17 Deputies were dispatched to a theft in the 700 block of Birch Ave. Parties living at the residence said that tattoo guns and equipment had been taken out of a vehicle parked in front of the house. The items were later recovered.

30-Mar-17 Deputies were called to a possible theft of items at a residence in Otis. The items were taken some time between November 2016 and January 2017. Case is under investigation.
