05/05/17 through 05/12/17

05-May-17 Deputies arrested Thomas Barnes after learning that he was driving while his license was under restraint. He was transported to the Washington County Justice Center and was later released on a \$10,000.00 PR bond.

05-May-17 While in custody, Richard Marr was arrested on a warrant out of Denver Municipal Court. He is being held on a \$500.00 bond.

05-May-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible disturbance at a residence in the town of Otis. Upon further investigation it was determined that it was only a verbal argument.

05-May-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible assault in Cope. After talking to multiple parties a warrant was issued for Leyton Laybourn. Mr. Laybourn was later arrested and charged with Intimidating a witness, menacing with a deadly weapon, 3rd degree assault, & criminal mischief \$300.00 or more. He was transported to the Washington County Justice Center and is being held on \$75,000.00 bond.

06-May-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible disturbance in the town of Cope. Upon further investigation, Raul Coronado was arrested and charges with Menacing with a deadly weapon, criminal mischief, & harassment. He was transported to the Washington County Justice Center and is being held on a \$35,000.00 bond.

07-May-17 An Akron resident brought a dog to the Sheriff's Office that she had found wandering around 6th. The dog was taken to the Akron Pound. The owner later came to pick up the dog. J'Lyn Bernhardt was given a warning for animal at large.

09-May-17 A dog was returned to the Akron Pound after the new owner reported that the dog was not getting along with her dogs. The dog will be taken to a shelter in Denver this weekend.

09-May-17 While in custody, Brandon Locklear was arrested on a warrant out of Logan County for failure to comply. He is being held without bond.

09-May-17 While in custody, Pierre Andre Madrigal was arrested on a warrant out of Adams County. He is being held on a \$2000.00 warrant.

09-May-17 Deputies were dispatched to the 26000 block of CO RD 45 on a disgruntled customer. Upon further investigation, it was determined that the customer didn't have the proper paperwork to pick up his vehicle out of the impound. The disgruntled customer had already left when deputies arrived.
