13-Jan-17 Deputies received a call in reference to animal waste being left at the Town of Akron Shop. Parties were interviewed and agreed to resolve the situation. No charges will be filed.

13-Jan-17 Deputies received a report of a possible cold trespass that occurred in the 23000 block of CO RD 10. The case is under investigation.

13-Jan-17 Deputies were dispatched to a two non-injury vehicle accident at the Ambulance Barn in Otis. Marcelyn Patterson backed into Linda Bethel's vehicle. Bethel's vehicles sustained moderate the rear driver's side. Patterson's vehicle sustained a paint transfer to the rear passenger's side. Neither party was cited.

14-Jan-17 Deputies were dispatched to a possible assault in the town of Akron. Upon further investigation, Daniel Roy was arrested and transported to the Washington County Justice Center on charges of 3rd Degree Assault. Mr. Roy was later released on a \$2000.00 PR Bond.

17-Jan-17 Kenneth Maes was transferred from Larimer County Detention Center to the Washington County Justice Center on warrant out of Washington County Courts. Mr. Maes is being held on a \$200,000 bond.

18-Jan-17 Deputies were called to Family Dollar on a possible harassment. Reporting party told deputies that the juvenile who was harassing them was not allowed back in the store. Deputies were unable to locate the juvenile at the time.

18-Jan-17 Deputies observed a vehicle slide onto the sidewalk at 1st & Ash. Deputies attempted to make contact with the vehicle on Hwy 34 & CO RD BB but the vehicle fled on Hwy 34. The vehicle later crashed into a field. The juvenile driver was charged with Driving without a license, Disregard/Fail to stop as required at a stop sign at a thru highway, Speeding, Drove vehicle on a sidewalk, Eluding police, & Possession of drug paraphernalia. The juvenile was issued a summons and released to her grandfather.
