03-Feb-17 An Otis resident reported that she received a phone call from someone claiming to be with the Social Security Administration. The resident reported that the caller had her social security number and other personal identifying information. The resident provided the caller with her bank information and later had withdrawals on her account, without authorization. The case is under investigation. Residents are urged not to provide information and hang up on unsolicited callers seeking personal information

04-Feb-17 Deputies received a call about a dog at large. Upon further investigation, it was determined that the dog was found wandering on Hwy 63 near CO RD 47.
